APPENDIX 1

Requirements for the text:

In preparation, the texts follow the general text formatting rules. A Microsoft Word file (.doc, .docx, .rtf). The name of the file in the form: Last name of the author number of the thematic section. For example, *Ivanov_Section 1.doc*. Times New Roman headset, size 12. Interval 1.5. Width alignment. Abstract 12 fonts in 1 interval. Indentation for a paragraph is 1 cm, set automatically; all fields are 2 cm. Paragraph spacing is not allowed in the text. Double spaces are not allowed in the text. The author's initials and surname are indicated in ***bold italics*** in the right corner; the city and country are written in brackets and in *normal italics*; and the title of the article is written in **BOLD CAPITAL** letters in the center.

The article's main text is up to **3 pages long**, including footnotes.

Footnotes are in text in square brackets to the author's surname [Bakhtin, p.177].

Whenever you are mentioning several publications by the same authors in one link, you must write them in a row. «He» or «She» replaces the second and subsequent mentions of the surname in one footnote.

– In case of repeated reference to the same publication, the abbreviated title of the publication is given: the author, a few words from the title, an ellipsis, the volume number (if the publication is multi-volume) and the page number.

– In case of repeated reference to the same author, but to another work, it is necessary to indicate his surname, the year of publication and the number of pages [Ivanov, 2017, p. 152].

After the main text, **a list of used literature** is given, which should include only research literature (articles, monographs, collections of documents, abstracts of dissertations), which are included as footnotes in the article text. The bibliography is not numbered and alphabetical.

Attention! Page footnotes are forbidden. References to literature should be placed in square brackets [Arutyunova 1976: 15]

Bibliographic descriptions of sources are given after the article text, under the word Literature (bold in the center), in accordance with the samples.

A selection of texts that do not match the subjects of the sections and the format guidelines will be rejected by the editorial board of the proceeding.
