

Procedure for the arrival of international students from CIS states

Greetings, UrFU student! We are glad to inform you that the University is waiting for you in the new academic year 2021/22. The following are the arrival conditions in the city of Yekaterinburg.

Before your arrival in Russia

- 1** To inform the International Students Adaptation Center of your arrival, you should fill in the Google form **at least 10 days** before your arrival ➡
! If you are crossing the border **by land**, you must inform the International Students Adaptation Centre (adaptation@urfu.ru) of the date of entry into Russia at least 10 days before arrival. You should also specify your full name in Latin characters as in a passport or ID card, the number of this document, date of birth, gender, nationality. This information is required to put you on the land border crossing list, otherwise you will not be permitted to cross the border.
- 2** You should take your first PCR test for COVID-19 in your country **no earlier than 3 days before** arriving in Russia.
- 3** When crossing the border, you should have your medical certificate with a negative PCR test result in Russian or English.

After your arrival in Russia

- 1** You must do a second PCR test for COVID-19 within 3 days after entering Russia.
Normally the result of the test is available within 24 hours. If you arrive in Yekaterinburg transiting via Moscow, we recommend doing the second PCR test in Moscow (e.g. at the airport) in order to speed up the receipt of the result.
- 2** You must maintain self-isolation until the results of the second PCR test are available.
For short-term isolation, you can either contact the International Students Adaptation Center (1st student dormitory, 79 Bolshakova Street) or the Students' Union project office 'Rent Flats' (Yulia Tolmacheva, ☎ +79826433495) in advance.
- 3** After receiving the second PCR result, scanned copies of both certificates with negative PCR tests' results should be sent to the International Students Adaptation Centre.



If you need accompaniment upon arrival in Yekaterinburg, as well as meetings at the airport or train station, please contact the Adaptation Centre (adaptation@urfu.ru) or phone: +7(343)375-41-93 at least 3 days before your arrival in Russia.

In order to obtain a dormitory contract, you are required to:

- ☐ Have no more than 2 academic debts;
- ☐ Notify the Institute Accommodation Committee in advance of your arrival;
- ☐ Have a medical examination in the Medical Sanitary Unit of Ural Federal University (59B, Komsomolskaya street);
- ☐ Get additional health insurance at any insurance company;
- ☐ Receive a contract for accommodation in the International Students Center
You should bring your passport, additional health insurance policy, medical examination card, two certificates with negative results of PCR examinations.
For students on the quota of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, an agreement must be obtained at the Foreign Students Admission Centre (Zvezdny Student Centre, 3/1 Komintern Street). The certificate of admission to the educational process will also be issued there.
For students on a contract, it is required to obtain a certificate of admission to the educational process at the Foreign Students Admission Centre (Zvezdny Centre, 3/1 Komintern Street) and then the contract at the housing commission of your institute.

You can apply for migration registration in the office of GUK-109 (19 Mira Street).

If you do not intend to get a place in the University dormitory, you still need to obtain a certificate of admission to study at the International Student Centre
(Zvezdnyi Centre, Komintern Street 3/1)

You should have a passport, an additional health insurance policy, two certificates with negative results of PCR examinations.
You will have to write a refusal of dormitory accommodation stating the address of the intended accommodation.



If symptoms of an acute respiratory illness occur during isolation (fever, sore throat, runny nose, cough), you should immediately inform the university (your institute and the Adaptation Centre) and call the doctor.
